



# **CODING & ROBOTICS CAMP INFORMATION SHEET**

#### Who is the camp suitable for?


 Our Coding and Robotics Camps are open to boys and girls aged between 6-10 years of age. We do offer camps for older children aged 10-16 years. The age will be displayed on the camp details. 10-year-olds can go to either camp.

### Do you need prior coding experience?

- No prior coding experience is necessary to attend the camps.
- If your child has been to one of these workshops before, then their learning will be extended further and they will not have to repeat the same content as before.

#### Where is the drop off and pick up point?

Our Coding and Robotics camp is in the Senior School. Please use the postcode CR3 6YA which brings you to the main entrance of the school. Please use the car park spaces in front of the school (lower and upper car parks) and register your child with the Code Kids camp manager outside the front of the school reception doors. Pick up is in the same location unless you have booked wraparound care. Please see Wraparound care information further down.

#### Wraparound care info

- We offer wraparound care for this camp from 8am until 6pm. You can book wraparound sessions separately on Bookaby. If you have booked the wraparound care, then please drop off and collect from the location specified in the session details on Bookaby.

#### What should my child wear?

- This is predominantly an indoor camp which takes place in classrooms or a large hall on Lego Robotics days. There are several opportunities for outside play at breaks and lunch time so on rainy or cold days your child will need a coat.

#### What else will we need to bring on the day?

- Please bring a packed lunch with snacks for morning and afternoon breaks. Please do NOT put any nuts or nut products in your child's lunch box
- A refillable water bottle so they can keep hydrated during the camp
- Any medicines. There will be an opportunity to outline any medical needs during the booking process.
- All equipment is provided for the younger classes so your child will not need to bring any specific IT equipment
- The Roblox and Python coding camps require your child to bring a laptop computer with certain software installed. Download Python software <u>here</u> for the Python coding course. Download Roblox Studio <u>here</u> for the Roblox Course. These will only work on a Mac or Windows laptop/computer.





#### Class Dojo

- We take photos of the children as they work and post them on Class Dojo's secure
  platform. The evening before the event, you will get an invite from Class Dojo (do, please
  check spam).
- If you do not wish your child to have any photos taken, then please opt out of this in the booking process.

## Can my child attend just for one day?

- Yes. We do take bookings for individual days, but we do offer a 5% discount for a full week booking.
