

CRAFTY KIDS CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

Who is the camp suitable for?

- Our Crafty Kids Camps are open to boys and girls aged between 5 -11 years of age provided they are at least in year 1 or going into year 1 in September for the summer holiday courses.
- Each day has a different theme so please check the theme is of interest to your child before booking a particular day for example some days we do clay modelling.

How do you split the group?

- The group tends to stay together however when we have distinct disparity in ages, we will split the group so that the older kids can work at a different pace to the younger ones.
- The camp manager has the ages of the attendees in advance and will plan the camp around the attendees.

Where is the drop off and pick up point?

- The drop off and pick up location for the Crafty Kids camp is in the Senior School main entrance. Please use the postcode CR3 6YA which brings you here. Please use the car park spaces in front of the school (lower and upper car parks) and register your child inside the front doors of the school with the Crafty Kids camp manager. Drop off and pick up is in the same location unless you have booked wraparound care. Please see Wraparound care information further down.

Wraparound care info

- We offer wraparound care for this camp from 8am until 6pm. You can book wraparound sessions separately on Bookaby. If you have booked the wraparound care, then please drop off and collect from the location specified in the session details on Bookaby.

What should my child wear?

This is predominantly an indoor camp which takes place in classrooms. There are several
opportunities for outside play at breaks and lunch time so on rainy or cold days your child
will need a coat.

What else will we need to bring on the day?

- Please bring a packed lunch with snacks for morning and afternoon breaks. Please do NOT put any nuts or nut products in your child's lunch box.
- A refillable water bottle so they can keep hydrated during the camp.
- All equipment is provided so your child will not need to bring anything.
- A spare carrier bag to put any art and craft work to take home in.
- Any medicines. There will be an opportunity to outline any medical needs during the booking process.

Can my child attend just for one day?

Yes. We do take bookings for individual days.
