

MUSICAL THEATRE CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

Who is the camp suitable for?

- Our Musical theatre camp is open to boys and girls aged between 6-18 years of age.
- Performers are split into age groups; 6-11yrs (Juniors) and 12-18yrs (Seniors).

Do you need prior experience?

- No prior experience is necessary to attend the camps, but it is helpful to know what experience each child has beforehand to ensure that they are managed effectively to get the most out of the camp.

Where is the drop off and pick up point?

- Our Musical theatre camp is in the Performing Arts Centre in the Senior School. Please use the postcode CR3 6YA which brings you to the main entrance of the school. Please use the car park spaces in front of the school (lower and upper car parks) and follow the signs from the front of the school by foot to take you to the Performing Arts Centre building where you can register your child. Pick up is in the same location unless you have booked wraparound care. Please see Wraparound care information further down.

What should my child wear?

- Please make sure each performer wears suitable, comfortable clothing and wears soft/comfortable shoes that are easy to dance in.
- Although the camp is taking place indoors, there will be opportunity for outdoor play during break times so please ensure your child is wearing suitable clothing.

What else will we need to bring on the day?

- Please bring a packed lunch with snacks for morning and afternoon breaks. Please do NOT put any nuts or nut products in your child's lunch box
- A refillable water bottle so they can keep hydrated during the camp
- Any medicines. There will be an opportunity to outline any medical needs during the booking process.

Can my child attend just for one day?

- No, this is a two-day camp.
