

WILDCATS ADVENTURE CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

Who is the camp suitable for?

Our WildCats Adventure Camps are open to children aged 8+ with a head for heights! We strongly advise only booking this camp if your child has previously been on a similar course such as Go Ape. As all the activities on offer are at height, there are no other alternatives if your child does not want to take part. All staff are required to lead an activity so will not be able to supervise children not taking part at ground level.

Where is the drop off and pick up point?

Drop off and collection will take place in the **Prep School** car park close to the 'WildCats' area between the senior and prep schools. Please use the postcode CR3 6YB which brings you to the Prep School car park. Pick up is in the same location unless you have booked wraparound care. Please see Wraparound care information further down.



Wraparound care info

- We offer wraparound care for this camp from 8am until 6pm. You can book wraparound sessions separately on Bookaby. If you have booked the wraparound care, then please drop off and collect from the location specified in the session details on Bookaby.

What should my child wear?

- As this is an outdoor camp your child's clothing is essential. Even during warm weather we advise children wear long sleeves and trousers to protect their skin from the natural environment on the high ropes course.
- A pair of sturdy boots for grip when climbing!
- Gloves are also a good option to bring when climbing.

What else will we need to bring on the day?

- Please bring a packed lunch with snacks for morning and afternoon breaks. **Please do NOT put any nuts or nut products in your child's lunch box**
- A refillable water bottle so they can keep hydrated during the camp
- Any medicines. There will be an opportunity to outline any medical needs during the booking process.

- 10.00-11.30am – Session 1
- 11.30-11.45am – Break
- 11.45am- 1.15pm Session 2
- 1.15-2.00pm – Lunch
- 2.00-3.30pm Session 3
- 3.30pm – Collection
