

## NETBALL CAMP INFORMATION SHEET

### Who is the camp suitable for?

- Our camps are for boys and girls aged 7–14. Whether your child is new to netball or already plays regularly, they'll be supported and challenged at their level.
- There will be an opportunity to provide details of your child's playing experience during the booking process.

### Where is the drop off and pick up point?

- Please drop your child off **at the Sports Centre**. Registration opens at 9.20am. There is ample parking in the Sports Centre Car Park. Pick up is in the same location unless you have booked wraparound care. Please see Wraparound care information further down.



### Wraparound care info

- We offer wraparound care for this camp from 8am until 6pm. You can book wraparound sessions separately on Bookaby. If you have booked the wraparound care, then please drop off and collect from the location specified in the session details on Bookaby.

### What equipment do we need to bring?

- Suitable sports clothing such as shorts, tracksuit and trainers. The camps mainly take place outdoors so packing rain jacket would be advisable. There is an indoor back up venue in the event of severe wet weather.

### What else will we need to bring on the day?

- Please bring a packed lunch with snacks for morning and afternoon breaks. **We are a nut free site so absolutely NO NUTS**
- A refillable water bottle so they can keep hydrated during the camp.

### How is the camp structured?

- While every day is a little different, here's the usual schedule:
  - o Welcome & Introduction – Meet the coaches and go over a few key rules. Then we'll split into groups based on age or ability.
  - o Morning Session – Warm-up followed by 2.5 hours of coaching, with a short snack break.
  - o Lunch Break
  - o Afternoon Session – Another 2.5 hours of coaching and fun gameplay.
  - o Wrap-Up & Prizes – We finish the day with a short debrief and some well-earned prizes!

### Medicines/Medical needs

- If your child has a severe allergy that requires an EpiPen, you **MUST** outline this to us when booking your child onto the camp, ensuring you have given us all relevant information.
- If your child requires an EpiPen or Inhaler **it is imperative that you send your child in with two EpiPens or two Inhalers**. If your child turns up to camp without two they will be turned away and sent home.
- Please also inform us of any hidden needs, disabilities or learning difficulties so we can ensure your child receives the correct care for them.
